Foreign players not registered with a Swiss Club must submit to the Secretariat of the host club certification of their Hcp, issued by the Club of origin or Federation.		
	Depending on the number of participants, 3 or 4 categories of HCP will be awarded.		
Insurance:	Each individual player must be privately insured against injury and ensure that he or she is in a state of health to enable him or her to play the challenge. The cantonal medical service is available for any eventuality.		

# GOLF CLUB LUGANO



The Golf Club Lugano, one of the first golf courses in Switzerland, was created by Erwin von Riedemann to show his love for his wife Josefa. It was inaugurated in Magliaso on 24 November 1923.

Created as a 9-hole course by architect Percy Dell, it was extended to 18 holes by Donald Harradine in 1970. It is a small miracle: mainly because, the land on which the course now stands is only 32 hectares, while the modern courses occupy some 50 hectares. The holes alternate well, offering interesting challenges to both novices and professionals.

The Lugano Golf Club also hosts the Lugano Golf Academy, with four of the best professionals in Ticino.

Today, the course follows a path along the Magliasina river on flat terrain between birch, oak, pine, beech, rhododendron, oleander and azalea forests, among which one encounters many squirrels and even the splendid heron, which often stops between holes 10 and 11.
